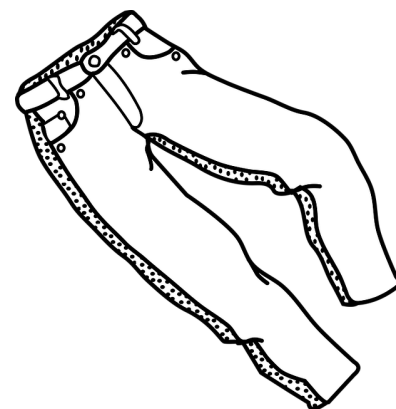
Help us to be patient with your timing and to trust that your ways are perfect!
